A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state to the
- 2 Iowa state commerce commission and various divisions thereof.
- 3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

Passed House as amended 5/23; 105-0

- 4 Section 1. For the Iowa state commerce commission there is
- 5 hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state for each
- 6 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending June 30,
- 7 1971, the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be neces-
- 8 sary, to be used in the manner designated:

9 1. GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

- 10 For salaries of the commissioners, the
- 11 salary for two members of the Iowa
- 12 state commerce commission shall be four-
- 13 teen thousand (14,000) dollars and the
- 14 salary of one member shall be thirteen
- 15 thousand (13,000) dollars for each year of
- 16 the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and
- 17 ending June 30, 1971

19	For other salaries	129,310.00
20	For support, maintenance and

15 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of
 16 the Iowa state commerce commission and divisions thereof are
 17 hereby appropriated for the purpose set forth in such federal
 18 grants or receipts.

19 Sec. 3. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used
 20 for capital improvements.

21 Sec. 4. Where any of the laws of this state are in conflict
 22 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
 23 biennium.

24 Sec. 5. The provisions of chapter eight (8) of the Code are
 25 hereby made applicable to this Act.

26 Sec. 6. Section four hundred ninety A point ten (490A.10) of
 27 the Code as amended by chapter one (1) section sixty-seven (67),
 28 Acts of the Sixty-second General Assembly, is hereby amended by
 29 striking from line fifty-four (54) the words and figures "four
 30 hundred twenty-five (425)" and inserting in lieu thereof the
 31 words and figures "four hundred sixty (460)".

1 Amend House File 817 by adding after line eighteen
2 (18), page 2, the following new sections.
3 Sec. 3. Section four hundred eighty-nine point three
4 (489.3), Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:
5 1. By striking all of line six (6) and inserting in lieu
6 thereof the figure and words "3. The starting point, route,
7 and terminus".
8 2. By inserting in line three (3) of subsection eight (8)
9 after the word "allegation" the following:
10 " , with specific facts demonstrating that the proposal is not
11 inconsistent with any comprehensive land utilization plans or
12 programs; that alternative routes and power sources have been
13 explored and are either unavailable or are unsatisfactory; and
14 that consideration of all other relevant factors and alterna-
15 tives indicate the desirability of the proposal nder con-
16 sideration."
17 Sec. 4. Section four hundred eighty-nine point four (489.4),
18 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:
19 1. By striking from line four (4) the word "may" and in-
20 serting in lieu thereof the word "shall".
21 2. By striking from line five (5) the word "or" and in-
22 serting in lieu thereof the word "and".
23 3. By inserting in line sixteen (16) after the word "use"
24 the following: " , that environmental factors adjacent to the
25 route of the proposed line and possible alternative routes
26 have been fully considered; that the proposal reflects sound
27 engineering principles in its approach to a rational distri-
28 bution and transmission of electric current for the state of
29 Iowa; and that such proposal bears a reasonable relationship
30 to one-system planing in the public interest".
31 Sec. 5. Section four hundred eighty-nine point five
32 (489.5), Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding to the end
33 thereof the following:
34 "In the event any objection is sustained in whole or in
35 part, the board or commission shall allow a reasonable fee
36 for the objector's attorney as part of the costs to be paid
37 by the petitioner."
