A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act to designate Herbert Hoover Day as a state holiday.
- 2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 3 Section 1. The Sunday which falls on or nearest the tenth
- 4 day of August of each year is hereby designated as Herbert
- 5 Hoover Day, which shall be a state holiday in honor of the
- 6 late President Herbert Hoover. The governor is hereby auth-
- 7 orized and requested to issue annually a proclamation
- 8 designating such Sunday as Herbert Hoover Day and calling
- 9 on the people and officials of the state of Iowa to commem-
- 10 orate the life and principles of Herbert Hoover, to display
- 11 the American flag, and to hold appropriate services and
- 12 ceremonies.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 95

This bill will designate the Sunday nearest the tenth day of August of each year as Herbert Hoover Day to honor the late president. The governor is requested to issue a proclamation designating the holiday.
