HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution
- 2 of the State of Iowa to authorize the licensing and regula-
- 3 tion of bingo games conducted by charitable, religious, or
- 4 veterans organizations.
- 5 *Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 the State of Iowa is hereby proposed:
- 8 Section twenty-eight (28) of Article three (III) of the
- 9 Constitution of the State of Iowa is hereby repealed and the
- 10 following adopted in lieu thereof:
- 11 "Section 28. No lottery shall be authorized by this State;
- 12 nor shall the sale of lottery tickets be allowed; but nothing
- 13 in this section shall be construed to prohibit the enactment
- 14 of laws by the General Assembly providing for the licensing
- 15 and regulation of bingo games conducted by charitable organiza-
- 16 tions, religious organizations, or veterans organizations
- 17 chartered by the Congress of the United States."
- 18 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment to the Constitu-
- 19 tion of the State of Iowa is hereby referred to the general
- 20 assembly to be chosen at the next general election for members
- 21 of the general assembly and the secretary of state is directed
- 22 to cause the same to be published for three consecutive months
- 23 previous to the date of said election as provided by law.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 10

This resolution proposes an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa to authorize the licensing and regulation of bingo games conducted by charitable, religious, and veterans organizations. The amendment also retains the prohibition on lotteries and the sale of lottery tickets.

2 1. Page one (1), by striking lines eight (8) through
3 seventeen (17), inclusive, and inserting in lieu thereof
4 the following:
5 "Section twenty-eight (28) of Article three (III) of the
6 Constitution of the State of Iowa is hereby repealed."
7 2. Page one (1), by striking the title on lines one (1)
8 through four (4), inclusive, and inserting in lieu thereof
9 the following:
10 "A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Con-
11 stitution of the State of Iowa repealing the prohibition
12 against lotteries in order that they may be regulated by
13 the General Assembly."
14 3. By striking the explanation and inserting in lieu
15 thereof the following:
16 "This proposed amendment repeals the Constitutional
17 prohibition against lotteries, leaving their use or prohibi-
18 tion to the discretion of the legislature."
