## A BILL FOR

1 An Act authorizing the state board of regents to authorize  
 2 institutions under its control to commission special se-  
 3 curity officers with peace officer authority.  
 4 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*  
 5 Section 1. Chapter two hundred sixty-two (262), Code 1966,  
 6 is hereby amended by adding the following thereto:  
 7 "The board may authorize any institution under its control  
 8 to commission one or more of its employees as special security  
 9 officers. Special security officers shall have the powers,  
 10 privileges, and immunities of regular peace officers when  
 11 acting in the interests of the institution by which they are  
 12 employed. The board shall provide as rapidly as practicable  
 13 for the adequate training of such special security officers  
 14 at the Iowa law enforcement academy or in an equivalent  
 15 training program, unless they have already received such  
 16 training."

 2 after the word, "institution" the words, "and upon the premises  
 3 of such institution".
