A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to secondary roads.
- 2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 3 Section 1. Section three hundred nine point sixty-eight
- 4 (309.68), Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding the following
- 5 new subsection:
- 6 "Make joint agreements for the location, construction, and
- 7 maintenance of secondary roads wholly within one county to
- 8 provide road access to lands in an adjoining county, when such
- 9 location provides the most economical and practical method of
- 10 providing such road access. The expense of constructing and
- 11 maintaining such a road shall be equitably shared by the coun-
- 12 ties in such proportion as the boards may determine."
- 13 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
- 14 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-
- 15 tion in the LeMars Daily Sentinel, a newspaper publish in *Frank*
- 16 LeMars, Iowa, and in The Merville Record, a newspaper published *3/4*
- 17 in Merville, Iowa.

EXPLANATION

This bill will permit adjoining counties to share costs of a secondary road wholly within one county where such a road is necessary to provide road access for land in the adjoining county.
