- 1 An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of
- 2 Iowa for capital improvements at the Iowa soldiers' home at
- 3 Marshalltown.
- 4 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 5 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general
- 6 fund of the state of Iowa to the department of social services
- 7 the sum of one hundred five thousand six hundred (105,600)
- 8 dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used
- 9 for air conditioning of the hospital building at the Iowa sol-
- 10 diers' home, Marshalltown, Iowa.
- 11 Sec. 2. Contracts for the improvement authorized by this
- 12 Act shall be submitted by the department of social services to
- 13 the executive council, except that items commonly known as
- 14 change orders need not be submitted to the executive council
- 15 unless such change orders actually increase the total cost of
- 16 this particular project.
- 17 Sec. 3. The department of social services, the governor,
- 18 and the state comptroller are hereby authorized to obtain fed-
- 19 eral grants to be used in connection with the funds appropri-
- 20 ated by this Act.

- 1 Sec. 4. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June 30,
- 2 1973, shall revert to the general fund of the state as of June
- 3 30, 1973.
