1 An Act relating to county agricultural extension districts.

2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

3 Section 1. Section one hundred seventy-six A point ten
4 (176A.10), Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

5 1. By striking from line thirteen (13) the word "one-
6 half" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "three-fourths".

7 2. By striking from line seventeen (17) the word "thirty"
8 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "seventy-five".

9 3. By striking from line eighteen (18) the word "fifty-
10 five" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifty".

11 4. By striking from line nineteen (19) the word "twenty-
12 five" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifty".

13 5. By striking from lines twenty-one (21) and twenty-two
14 (22) the words "of twenty thousand but not more than fifty-
15 five" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "under fifty".

16 6. By striking from lines twenty-two (22) through
17 twenty-five (25), inclusive, the words "in excess of seventeen
18 thousand five hundred dollars in districts having a population
19 of not more than twenty thousand,".

EXPLANATION

This bill increased the maximum annual mill levy for the county agricultural extension education fund from one-half to three-fourths mill. The maximum dollar amount of such annual levy is increased to \$75,000 for districts having a population of 50,000 or more and to \$50,000 for districts having a population under 50,000.

EXPLANATION

This bill increased the maximum annual mill levy for the county agricultural extension education fund from one-half to three-fourths mill. The maximum dollar amount of such annual levy is increased to seventy-five thousand dollars for districts having a population of fifty thousand or more and to fifty thousand dollars for districts having a population under fifty thousand.

10 for financing the county agricultural extension education
11 program authorized in this chapter. The amount so estimated
12 for the 'county agricultural extension education fund' shall
13 not exceed three-fourths mill on the dollar of assessed valua-
14 tion per year. The extension council shall in every respect
15 comply with chapter twenty-four (24) of the Code."
