## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act authorizing counties to cooperate with federal programs.
- 2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 3 Section 1. Chapter four hundred forty-four (444), Code 1966,
- 4 is hereby amended by adding the following new section:
- 5 "The board of supervisors of any county may levy not to
- 6 exceed one mill on a dollar of assessed valuation for the
- 7 purpose of matching funds available to such county from federal
- 8 programs including, but not limited to, crime control, public
- 9 health, civil defense, highway safety, juvenile delinquency,
- 10 narcotics control and pollution. The levy authorized by this
- 11 section is in addition to and shall not be subject to any mill
- 12 levy limitation otherwise provided by law."

### EXPLANATION

This Act allows a levy of not to exceed one mill by county governments in order to cooperate with and meet financial obligations in regard to the establishment of programs involving counties and the federal government.

7 Assembly, is hereby further amended by adding the following  
8 subsection:  
9 "To appropriate funds from the general fund to match any  
10 grant to the county under any state or federal program for the  
11 study, control and suppression of crime."

3 1. By striking line 11 and inserting in lieu thereof  
4 the following words: "purpose of matching funds available  
5 to such county from federal programs including, but not  
6 limited to, crime control, public health, civil defense,  
7 highway safety, juvenile delinquency, narcotic control  
8 and pollution."  
9 2. By adding after line 11 the following new section:  
10 "Section twenty-four point six (24.6), Code 1966, is  
11 amended by inserting after the period in line twenty-one (21)  
12 the following words:  
13 "Approval may be granted by the state board upon an  
14 application approved by a two-thirds vote of the board of  
15 supervisors of a county to use this fund for the purpose  
16 of matching funds available to such county from federal  
17 programs including, but not limited to, crime control,  
18 public health, civil defense, highway safety, juvenile  
19 delinquency, narcotics control and pollution."
