# A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to employment agencies and the fees charged  
2 thereby.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. Section ninety-four point six (94.6), Code  
5 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

6 1. By striking from lines eight (8) through twelve (12),  
7 inclusive, the words "but in no event shall the charge for  
8 the furnishing or procurement of any situation or employment  
9 be in excess of five percent of the annual gross earnings."  
10 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "but in no event shall  
11 the charge to an applicant for employment exceed ten percent  
12 of actual gross earnings where such employment does not last  
13 at least sixty days. In all other instances the employment  
14 agency may charge such fees as it shall determine, provided  
15 a schedule thereof shall be filed with the commission, and  
16 any change therein shall not be effective until thirty days  
17 after filing."

18 2. By inserting in line sixteen (16) after the word  
19 "enterprises" the words "or to fees charged solely to em-  
20 ployers where no fee is charged to the employee".

- 1 Sec. 2. Section ninety-four point seven (94.7), Code
- 2 1966, is hereby amended by striking from lines two (2) and
- 3 three (3) the words "an application" and inserting in lieu
- 4 thereof the words "any applicant".
