A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the residency requirements for civil service
2 workers.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. Section three hundred sixty-five point seven-
5 teen (365.17), Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

6 1. By striking from lines twenty-two (22) through twenty-
7 four (24), inclusive, the words "and has been a resident of
8 the state of Iowa for at least one year".

9 2. By striking from lines thirty-seven (37) through forty-
10 four (44), inclusive, the following:

11 "Except with respect to appointment or employment in the
12 police or fire department, the civil service commission may
13 waive the residence requirement as set out in subsection one
14 (1), in examinations for positions requiring technical or
15 scientific knowledge when applicants for such positions are
16 not available who can meet the residence requirement."

EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 244

This bill will repeal from the municipal civil service requirements that part which requires a person to be a resident of the state for at least one year, and also the provision allowing the civil service commission to waive the residency requirement for employment requiring special skills when it is necessary to obtain qualified persons.

1 Amend Senate File 244, page 1, by adding after line 16
2 a new section as follows:
3 "Senate File 339, as enacted by the Sixty-third General
4 Assembly, Second Session, is amended by striking section
5 two (2)."
