## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to seasons for hunting fur-bearing animals.

2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

3 Section 1. Section one hundred nine point eighty-seven

4 (109.87), Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

5 1. By striking from lines eight (8) and nine (9) the words

6 "between September 1 and March 1 both dates inclusive,".

7 2. By striking lines nineteen (19) through thirty-five

8 (35), inclusive, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

9 "1. Mink—November 1-February 28

10 2. Otter—November 1-February 28

11 3. Muskrat—November 1-April 30

12 4. Beaver—November 1-April 30

13 5. Raccoon—September 1-April 30

14 6. Skunk—September 1-August 31

15 7. Civet Cat—September 1-August 31

16 8. Opossum—September 1-April 30

17 9. Badger—September 1-April 30

18 10. Red Fox or Gray Fox—September 1-August 31

19 11. Weasel—September 1-August 31

20 12. Ground Hog—September 1-August 31

21 13. Wolf, Coyote—continuous open season.

22 Such open season shall begin at sunrise on the first day

23 thereof."
