A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to compensation of the mayor and councilmen.

2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

3 Section 1. Section three hundred sixty-three B point nine

4 (363B.9), Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking lines

5 thirty-nine (39) through fifty-three (53), inclusive, and

6 inserting in lieu thereof the following new subsections:

7 "In cities having by such census a population of sixty

8 thousand and less than ninety thousand, for the mayor, not

9 to exceed ten thousand eight hundred dollars, and for each

10 councilman, not to exceed nine thousand five hundred dollars."

11 "In cities having by such census a population of ninety

12 thousand and less than one hundred ten thousand, for the

13 mayor, not to exceed sixteen thousand dollars, and for each

14 councilman, not to exceed fourteen thousand four hundred

15 dollars."

16 "In cities having by such census a population of one hun-

17 dred ten thousand or more, for the mayor, not to exceed six-

18 teen thousand eight hundred dollars, and for each councilman,

19 not to exceed fifteen thousand four hundred dollars."

20 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,

21 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publi-

22 cation in The Cedar Rapids Gazette, a newspaper published

23 in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, and in The Marion Sentinel, a news-

24 paper published in Marion, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 369

This bill attempts to give the mayor and councilmen under the commission form of government more home rule as to their compensation and increases the salary restriction for those cities having a population of more than 60,000.

18 compensation is not fixed by law".

11 *except as provided in section three hundred sixty-three A point*
12 *four (363A.4), subsection two (2) of the Code, shall be fixed*
13 *by ordinance and shall be paid in full for all services connected*
14 *with their official duties."*
