A BILL FOR

Sub. for H. F. 490, 5-8

- 1 An Act relating to barbering fees.
- 2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 3 Section 1. Section one hundred forty-seven point eighty
- 4 (147.80), Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:
- 5 1. By striking subsection five (5) and inserting in lieu
- 6 thereof the following:
- 7 "For a license to practice dental hygiene, cosmetology, and
- 8 funeral directing and embalming, issued upon the basis of an
- 9 examination given by an examining board, ten dollars, and for
- 10 a license to practice barbering issued upon such basis, five
- 11 dollars."
- 12 2. By inserting in line twenty-three (23) of subsection
- 13 seven (7) after the word "optometry" the words "or barbering".
- 14 3. By striking subsection twelve (12) and inserting in lieu
- 15 thereof the following:
- 16 "For an inspection by the state department of health and an
- 17 original barber school license, two hundred fifty dollars; for
- 18 the renewal of a barber school license, an annual fee of one
- 19 hundred twenty-five dollars."
- 20 4. By striking subsection fourteen (14) and inserting in
- 21 lieu thereof the following:
- 22 "For an inspection by the state department of health and an
- 23 original barber shop license, a fee of twenty-five dollars; for
- 24 a barber shop license renewal, an annual fee of ten dollars."
- 25 5. By inserting after subsection fourteen (14) the follow-

1 ing three new subsections:

2 "For a barber's examination and a barber school instructor's
3 examination, a fee of twenty-five dollars; for an apprentice
4 barber's examination, a fee of fifteen dollars."

5 "For an original barber school instructor's license, and
6 the annual renewal of a barber school instructor's license, a
7 fee of twenty-five dollars."

8 "For an original apprentice barber's license, and the annual
9 renewal of an apprentice barber's license, a fee of five
10 dollars."

11 6. By renumbering the subsections appropriately.

12 Sec. 2. Section one hundred fifty-eight point eleven
13 (158.11), Code 1966, as amended by chapter one hundred sixty-
14 eight (168), section one (1), Acts of the Sixty-second General
15 Assembly, is hereby further amended as follows:

16 1. By inserting in line thirty-four (34) after the word
17 "to" the words "the inspection fee and".

18 2. By striking from lines thirty-six (36) and thirty-seven
19 (37) the words "barber shop or barber school hereafter opened
20 and every".

EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 405

This bill imposes new fees and amends the amount of fees currently being collected in connection with licenses, license renewals, inspections, and examinations of barbers, apprentice barbers, barber school instructors, barber shops, and barber schools.

2 1. By inserting after the enacting clause the
3 following:

4 Section 1. Section one hundred forty-seven point
5 fifty-two (147.52), Code 1966, is hereby repealed and the
6 following is enacted in lieu thereof:

7 "A person who has resided in this state for at
8 least one year shall be permitted to take the
9 examination for licensing in any of the professions
10 regulated under this chapter if that person has received
11 a diploma or certificate from an institution in another
12 state of the United States of America whose standards
13 and hourly requirements are equal to the minimum re-
14 quirements of this state."

15 2. By renumbering the following sections.

16 3. Amend the title by inserting after the word
17 "fees" the following: ", and relating to residence
18 requirements for admission to license examinations.
