1 An Act relating to the granting of military service exemption
2 benefits to dependents.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point one
5 hundred ninety-eight (321.198), Code 1966, is hereby amended
6 by adding at the end of said section the following:

7 "The provisions of this section shall also apply to the
8 spouse and children or ward of such military personnel when
9 such spouse, children or ward are living with the above de-
10 scribed military personnel outside of the state of Iowa and
11 provided that such extension of license does not exceed five
12 years."

EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 440

Section 321.98 of the Code affords military servicemen stationed outside of Iowa a six-month grace period after discharge to renew operators' and chauffeurs' licenses which would otherwise have expired. This bill extends the grace period to members of his family if they have been living with him outside of Iowa.
