## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to motor vehicles.
- 2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 3 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point one
- 4 hundred nine (321.109), Code 1966, as amended by chapter two
- 5 hundred seventy (270), section one (1), Acts of the Sixty-
- 6 second General Assembly, is further amended by adding after
- 7 the period in line forty-two (42) the following:
- 8 "Dealers may, in addition to other provisions of this sec-
- 9 tion, purchase from the department in-transit stickers, for
- 10 which a fee of two dollars per sticker shall be paid at time
- 11 of purchase. One such sticker shall be displayed on each
- 12 vehicle purchased from a dealer by a nonresident for removal
- 13 to the state of his residence, and one such sticker shall
- 14 also be displayed on each vehicle not currently registered in
- 15 Iowa and purchased by an Iowa dealer for removal to his place
- 16 of business in this state. Such stickers shall be void three
- 17 days after issuance by the seller dealer. Each sticker shall
- 18 be at least five and one-half inches by eight inches and shall
- 19 contain the following information:
- 20 1. The words 'in-transit' in at least two-inch bold type.
- 21 2. The dealer's license number.
- 22 3. The date issued.
- 23 4. The purchaser's name and address.
- 24 5. The word 'Iowa' in at least one-inch bold type.
- 25 6. The words 'good for three days after the date of

- 1 issuance'.  
 2 7. Such other information as the commissioner may require.  
 3 This information shall be on the gummed side of the sticker  
 4 and the sticker shall be made of such type of material as to  
 5 be self-destructive when the sticker is removed. The sales  
 6 invoice verifying the sale shall be in the possession of the  
 7 driver of the vehicle in transit and shall be signed by the  
 8 owner or an authorized individual of the issuing dealership."

#### EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 494

This will provide a means for individuals and out-of-state dealers purchasing vehicles of the type required to be registered in this state to return to their out-of-state residence, or for an Iowa dealer to return the vehicle to his place of business if it is purchased at a dealer auction.
