A BILL FOR

1 An Act to establish a state advisory council for vocational
2 education.

*Passed Senate per House
amendment 5-9; 53-0.*

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. Section two hundred fifty-eight point seven
5 (258.7), Code 1966, is hereby repealed and the following
6 enacted in lieu thereof:

7 "There is hereby established a state advisory council for
8 vocational education, consisting of thirteen members, which
9 shall be appointed by the governor. The term of each member
10 shall be for three years, except that for the initial appoint-
11 ments the governor shall specify the terms of each member so
12 that as nearly as possible, the terms of an equal number of
13 members shall expire on the first day of July of each year.

14 The advisory council shall serve in an advisory capacity
15 to the state board and shall perform such functions as may be
16 necessary in order for the state of Iowa to qualify for fed-
17 eral aids and grants to vocational education.

18 The advisory council shall include members who are:

19 1. Familiar with the vocational needs and the problems
20 of management and labor in the state.

21 2. Representatives of state industrial and economic devel-
22 opment agencies.

23 3. Representative of community and junior colleges and
24 other institutions of higher education, area vocational schools,
25 technical institutes, and postsecondary or adult education

1 institutions, which provide programs of vocational or tech-
2 nical education and training.

3 4. Familiar with the administration of state and local
4 vocational education programs.

5 5. Persons having special knowledge, experience, or quali-
6 fications with respect to vocational education and who are not
7 involved in the administration of state or local vocational
8 education programs.

9 6. Familiar with programs of technical and vocational edu-
10 cation, including programs in comprehensive secondary schools.

11 7. Representative of local educational agencies.

12 8. Representative of school boards.

13 9. Representative of manpower and vocational education
14 agencies in the state, including the comprehensive area man-
15 power planning system of the state.

16 10. Representative of school systems with large concen-
17 trations of academically, socially, economically, and cultur-
18 ally disadvantaged students.

19 11. Persons having special knowledge, experience, or quali-
20 fications, with respect to the special educational needs of
21 physically or mentally handicapped persons.

22 12. Representative of the general public, and not qualified
23 for membership under the preceding subsections, including a
24 person representative of and familiar with the problems of the
25 poor and disadvantaged.

26 13. Representative of prospective employers of vocationally
27 trained students.

28 Sec. 2. This bill, being deemed of immediate importance,

EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 544

This bill establishes a state advisory council for vocational education, in order to qualify the state to receive federal grants for vocational education under Public Law 90-576.

The council consists of thirteen members appointed by the governor, and representing a wide range of interests in the area of vocational education.
