Requested by Senator Clarke.

Prepared in regard to amendment to Senate File 58, a bill for an act relating to the compensation for members of examining boards.

Following is the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal as required by Rule 31:

The per diem expense for the nineteen examining boards, covered by this amendment, for the year ended June 30, 1968, was approximately \$56,000. Assuming that all the boards set their per diem at the maximum of \$40 as allowed under this amendment, it is estimated that the increase in per diem expense will amount to approximately \$55,000.

It is not possible to determine either the amount at which each board will set their per diem or the funds they will have available for the year beginning July 1, 1971, so only the maximum increase has been estimated.
