## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the court clerks.
- 2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 3 Section 1. Section six hundred six point eleven (606.11),
- 4 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:
- 5 1. By striking from line two (2) the word "immediately".
- 6 2. By adding thereto the following:
- 7 "Such memorandum shall be made before the end of the next
- 8 working day."

### EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 590

Many times an attorney will file a petition or pleading at closing time and often later at night, especially to attach or for a divorce and injunction. Many clerks file these petitions at home. A recent ruling by the District Court in Marshall County now makes this impossible. This bill makes clear that the clerk has at least one working day in which to docket these matters.
