A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate the car dispatcher revolving fund for
2 the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending June 30, 1971.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. The state car dispatcher is hereby authorized
5 to expend from the revolving fund established by section twenty-
6 one point six (21.6) of the Code for each year of the biennium,
7 beginning July 1, 1969 and ending June 30, 1971, not to exceed
8 one hundred five thousand five hundred fifty-five (105,555)
9 dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in
10 the following manner:

11 For salaries (including a salary of ten thousand (10,000)
12 dollars for the state car dispatcher), support, maintenance,
13 equipment and miscellaneous purposes\$105,555.00

14 Sec. 2. If the full amount authorized is not expended during
15 the first year, the unused portion shall carry forward and be
16 an addition to the amount authorized for the second year of the
17 biennium.

18 Sec. 3. The remainder of the fund is hereby appropriated
19 for the purchases of gasoline, oil, tires, repairs, and all
20 other maintenance expenses incurred in the operation of state
21 owned motor vehicles and contingencies arising during the bi-
22 ennium which are legally payable from the car dispatcher re-
23 volving fund, providing, that for the purpose of this Act a
24 necessity of additional operating funds under section one (1)
25 of this Act may be construed as a contingency.

- 1 Sec. 4. Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act
2 shall be allocated for contingencies it shall be determined
3 by the executive council that a contingency exists and that
4 the proposed allocation shall be for the best interest of the
5 state.
- 6 Sec. 5. The provisions of chapter eight (8), Code 1966,
7 are hereby made a part of this Act.
- 8 Sec. 6. Where any of the laws of this state are in con-
9 flict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern
10 for the biennium.
