A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate administration and educational train-
2 ing aid funds from the general fund of the state to
3 the department of public instruction.

4 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

5 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general
6 fund of the state to the department of public instruction for
7 each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending
8 June 30, 1971, the following amounts, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, to be used for the purposes designated:

10 1. MANPOWER DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING

11 For participation in the manpower
12 development and training Act. Funds
13 are to be used for the conduct of local
14 programs and state administration, to
15 the extent required, to match federal
16 funds to be expended by the United
17 States treasury for this purpose\$ 200,000.00

18 2. VOCATIONAL EDUCATION

19 For vocational education aid to secon-
20 dary schools and area schools. Funds ap-
21 propriated under this Act are to be used
22 for aid to school districts and area
23 schools for development and the conduct
24 of programs of vocational education in
25 accordance with the provisions of chap-

1 ter two hundred fifty-eight (258) and
2 chapter two hundred eighty A (280A)
3 of the Code, and further to purchase
4 instructional equipment for vocational
5 and technical courses of instruction
6 in such schools\$6,600,000.00

7 Sec. 2. Section two hundred fifty-eight point eight (258.8),
8 Code 1966, is hereby repealed.

9 Sec. 3. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used
10 for capital improvements.

11 Sec. 4. The provisions of chapter eight (8) of the Code
12 shall be applicable to this Act.

13 Sec. 5. Where any of the laws of this state are in con-
14 flict with this appropriation Act, the provisions of this
15 Act shall govern for the biennium.
