A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from moneys received by certain commis-
2 sions, boards, and departments.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. For the following commissions, boards, and de-
5 partments, there is hereby appropriated all funds received
6 under authority of the designated chapters or sections of the
7 Code for the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending June
8 30, 1971. The following amounts, or so much thereof as may
9 be necessary, are authorized to be expended from said receipts
10 for each year of the biennium to be used in the manner desig-
11 nated:

7 Sec. 2. The remainder of each of the various funds referred
8 to in section one (1) of this Act is hereby appropriated for
9 contingencies arising during the biennium which are legally
10 payable from the various funds.

11 Sec. 3. A contingency shall exclude any purpose or project
12 which was presented to the general assembly by way of a bill
13 and which failed to become enacted into law, however, for the
14 purpose of this Act a necessity of additional operating funds
15 may be construed as a contingency.

16 Sec. 4. Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act
17 shall be allocated for contingencies it shall be determined by
18 the governor and the state comptroller that a contingency
19 exists and that the proposed allocation shall be for the best
20 interest of the state.

21 Sec. 5. If the full amounts authorized in section one (1)
22 of this Act are not expended during the first year, the unused
23 portion shall carry forward and be an addition to the amount
24 authorized for the second year of the biennium.

25 Sec. 6. The provisions of chapter eight (8), Code 1966,
26 are hereby made a part of this Act.

27 Sec. 7. Where any of the laws of this state are in conflict
28 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
29 biennium.
