A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate moneys received by the board of exam-
2 iners in watchmaking.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. For the board of examiners in watchmaking
5 there is hereby appropriated all funds received under the
6 authority of chapter one hundred twenty (120) of the Code,
7 for the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending June 30,
8 1971. The following amount, or so much thereof as may be
9 necessary, is authorized to be expended from said receipts
10 for each year of the biennium to be used in the manner desig-
11 nated:

12 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment and
13 miscellaneous purposes\$3,800.00

14 Sec. 2. The remainder of the funds referred to in section
15 one (1) of this Act is hereby appropriated for contingencies
16 arising during the biennium which are legally payable from
17 said fund.

18 Sec. 3. A contingency shall exclude any purpose or project
19 which was presented to the general assembly by way of a bill
20 and failed to become enacted into law, however, for the pur-
21 pose of this Act a necessity of additional operating funds may
22 be construed as a contingency.

23 Sec. 4. Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act
24 shall be allocated for contingencies it shall be determined
25 by the executive council that a contingency exists and that

1 the proposed allocation shall be for the best interest of the
2 state.

3 Sec. 5. If the full amount authorized in section one (1)
4 is not expended during the first year, the unused portion
5 shall carry forward and be an addition to the amount autho-
6 rized for the second year of the biennium.

7 Sec. 6. The provisions of chapter eight (8) of the Code
8 are hereby made a part of this Act.

9 Sec. 7. Where any of the laws of this state are in con-
10 flict with this Act the provisions of this Act shall govern
11 for the biennium.

3 Section one hundred twenty point six (120.6), Code 1966, is
4 amended by adding at the end thereof the words "However, any
5 person who has served as a watchmaker in another state for three
6 years or more, whether or not said state requires a watchmaker's
7 certificate or license, shall be permitted to take the examina-
8 tion required by this chapter to obtain a certificate in this
9 state. Such showing of service in another state shall be
10 supported by the proper affidavits from responsible persons in
11 said other state."
