A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from moneys received by certain commis-
2 sions, boards, and departments for the biennium beginning
3 July 1, 1969 and ending June 30, 1971.

4 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

5 Section 1. For the following commissoins, boards, and de-
6 partments, there is hereby appropriated all funds received
7 under authority of the designated chapters or sections of the
8 Code for the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending June
9 30, 1971. The following amounts, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, are authorized to be expended from said re-
11 ceipts for each year of the biennium to be used in the man-
12 ner designated:

13 1. Accountancy, board of—chapter one
14 hundred sixteen (116) of the Code:
15 For salaries, support, maintenance,
16 equipment and miscellaneous purposes\$ 24,355.00

17 2. Architectural examiners, board of—
18 chapter one hundred eighteen (118) of the
19 Code:
20 For salaries, support, maintenance,
21 equipment and miscellaneous purposes\$ 14,290.00

22 3. Engineering examiners, board of—
23 chapter one hundred fourteen (114) of
24 the Code:
25 For salaries, support, maintenance,

1 equipment and miscellaneous purposes\$ 41,050.00

2 4. Judicial department statistician—

3 section six hundred six point fifteen

4 (606.15) of the Code:

5 For salaries, support, maintenance,

6 equipment and miscellaneous purposes\$ 25,250.00

7 5. Liquor control commission, Iowa—

8 beer permit fund—section one hundred

9 twenty-four point five (124.5) of the

10 Code:

11 For salaries, support, maintenance,

12 equipment and miscellaneous purposes\$ 19,000.00

13 Sec. 2. The remainder of each of the various funds referred

14 to in section one (1) of this Act is hereby appropriated for

15 contingencies arising during the biennium which are legally

16 payable from the various funds.

17 Sec. 3. A contingency shall exclude any purpose or project

18 which was presented to the general assembly by way of a bill

19 and which failed to become enacted into law; however, for the

20 purpose of this Act a necessity of additional operating funds

21 may be construed as a contingency.

22 Sec. 4. Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act

23 shall be allocated for contingencies it shall be determined

24 by the executive council that a contingency exists and that

25 the proposed allocation shall be for the best interest of the

26 state.

27 Sec. 5. If the full amounts authorized in section one (1)

28 are not expended during the first year, the unused portion

29 shall carry forward and be an addition to the amount authorized

30 for the second year of the biennium.

31 Sec. 6. The provisions of chapter eight (8), Code 1966,

32 are hereby made a part of this Act.

33 Sec. 7. Where any of the laws of this state are in conflict

34 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the

35 biennium.
