A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state to the
2 department of public safety and various divisions thereof.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. For the department of public safety there is
5 hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state for
6 each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending
7 June 30, 1971, the following amounts, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, to be used in the manner designated:

9 1. DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATION

10 For salary of commissioner\$ 16,500.00

11 For other salaries 168,610.00

12 For support, maintenance, and miscellaneous
13 purposes 21,850.00

14 For matching federal funds with approval of
15 the governor 200,000.00

16 Total for division of administration\$ 406,960.00

17 2. DIVISION OF CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION

18 For salaries and for the state's contribution
19 to the peace officers' retirement, accident, and
20 disability system provided in chapter ninety-
21 seven A (97A) of the Code, in the amount of six-
22 teen percent of the salaries of personnel
23 included in the system, including a salary of

24	biennium.

21 plus longevity. The current salary ranges of the other classifica-
22 tions in the highway patrol shall be increased by six percent (6%)
23 each year of the biennium, plus longevity.

24 Longevity shall be as provided in section 80.8 of the Code.

25 Other salaries of the division shall be as provided in the pay
26 plan as approved by the executive council."

2 1. By changing the comma in line twenty-three (23) of
3 page one (1) to a period, striking the remainder of the
4 page and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
5 "The salary of the director shall be thirteen thousand
6 two hundred fifty dollars for the first year of the
7 biennium, and fourteen thousand forty-five dollars for the
8 second year of the biennium, plus longevity. The current salary
9 ranges of the other peace-officer classifications of the
10 division, as defined in section ninety-seven A point one
11 (97A.1) of the Code, shall be increased by six percent (6%)
12 each year of the biennium, plus longevity.

13 Longevity shall be the same as provided in section eighty
14 point eight (80.8) of the Code for members of the highway
15 patrol.

16 Other salaries of the division shall be as provided in
17 the pay plan as approved by the executive council."

18 2. By striking on page two (2), all of line one (1) and
19 through the word "service" in line two (2).

20 3. By striking on page two (2) beginning with the comma
21 in line nineteen (19) through the word "service" in line
22 twenty-two (22) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

23 ". The salary for the chief shall be fourteen thousand
24 eight hundred forty dollars for the first year of the biennium
25 and fifteen thousand seven hundred thirty dollars for the
26 second year of the biennium, plus longevity. The current
27 salary ranges of the other classifications in the highway
28 patrol shall be increased by six percent (6%) each year of
29 the biennium, plus longevity.

30 Longevity shall be as provided in section eighty point
31 eight (80.8) of the Code.

32 Other salaries of the division shall be as provided in the
33 pay plan as approved by the executive council."
