A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from moneys received by certain com-
2 missions, boards, and departments.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. For the following commissions, boards, and de-
5 partments, there is hereby appropriated all funds received under
6 authority of the designated chapters or sections of the Code
7 for the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending June 30,
8 1971. The following amounts, or so much thereof as may be
9 necessary, are authorized to be expended from said receipts
10 for each year of the biennium to be used in the manner
11 designated:

12 1. Health, state department of—board of basic science
13 examiners fund—chapter one hundred forty-six (146) of the Code:
14 For support, maintenance, equipment and
15 miscellaneous purposes\$ 17,800.00

16 2. Health, state department of—board of funeral
17 directing and embalming examiners fund—section
18 one hundred forty-seven point one hundred one
19 (147.101) of the Code:
20 For support, maintenance, equipment and
21 miscellaneous purposes\$ 9,150.00

22 3. Health, state department of—board of
23 dentistry fund—chapter one hundred sixty-six
24 (166), Acts of the Sixty-second General Assembly:
25 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment

1 and miscellaneous purposes\$ 27,250.00

2 4. Health, state department of—operators'

3 certification fund—chapter one hundred thirty-

4 six A (136A) of the Code:

5 For salaries, support, maintenance, equip-

6 ment and miscellaneous purposes\$ 4,700.00

7 5. Health, state department of—state board

8 of optometry examiners fund—section one hun-

9 dred forty-seven point one hundred seventeen

10 (147.117) of the Code:

11 For salaries, support, maintenance, equip-

12 ment and miscellaneous purposes\$ 8,000.00

13 6. Health, state department of—state

14 board of physical therapy examiners fund—

15 section one hundred forty-seven point one

16 hundred fifteen (147.115) of the Code:

17 For salaries, support, maintenance, equip-

18 ment and miscellaneous purposes\$ 2,200.00

19 7. Health, state department of—state

20 board of medical examiners fund—section

21 one hundred forty-seven point one hundred

22 three (147.103) of the Code:

23 For salaries, support, maintenance, equip-

24 ment and miscellaneous purposes\$ 54,260.00

25 8. Nurse examiners, board of—nurse's

26 fund—section one hundred forty-seven point

27 one hundred seven (147.107) of the Code:

28 For salaries, support, maintenance, equip-

29 ment and miscellaneous purposes\$112,525.00

30 Sec. 2. The remainder of each of the various funds referred

31 to in section one (1) of this Act is hereby appropriated for

32 contingencies arising during the biennium which are legally

33 payable from the various funds.

34 Sec. 3. A contingency shall exclude any purpose or project

35 which was presented to the general assembly by way of a bill

1 and which failed to become enacted into law, however, for the
2 purpose of this Act an unforeseen necessity of additional oper-
3 ating funds may be construed as a contingency.

4 Sec. 4. Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act
5 shall be allocated for contingencies it shall be determined by
6 the executive council that a contingency exists and that the
7 proposed allocation shall be for the best interest of the
8 state.

9 Sec. 5. If the full amounts authorized in section one (1)
10 are not expended during the first year, the unused portion
11 shall carry forward and be an addition to the amount authorized
12 for the second year of the biennium.

13 Sec. 6. The provisions of chapter eight (8) of the Code
14 shall apply to this Act.

15 Sec. 7. Where any of the laws of this state are in con-
16 flict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern
17 for the biennium.
