## A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of  
2 Iowa to the state conservation commission for construction,  
3 replacement, development, and alterations to state parks  
4 and reserves, state forests, and state waters; for artifi-  
5 cial lake development, erosion control, river, stream, and  
6 lake access, development of water-oriented facilities, land  
7 acquisition; for siltation control; for boundary surveys,  
8 engineering services, and authorizing the obtaining and  
9 acceptance of federal funds to the state to be used in con-  
10 nection with this appropriation and federal funds in addi-  
11 tion thereto.

12 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

13 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the state con-  
14 servation commission from the general fund of the state of  
15 Iowa the sum of four hundred fifty thousand (450,000) dollars  
16 for construction, replacement, development, and alterations to  
17 state parks and reserves, state forests, and state waters; for  
18 artificial lake development, erosion control, river, stream,  
19 and lake access, development of water-oriented facilities,  
20 land acquisition; for siltation control and for boundary sur-  
21 veys, engineering services or to supplement any prior appro-  
22 priation for such items.

23 Sec. 2. Contracts for improvements for which funds are  
24 appropriated by this Act shall be submitted by the state con-  
25 servation commission to the executive council, except that

1 items commonly known as change orders need not be submitted to  
2 the executive council unless such change orders actually in-  
3 crease the total cost of that particular project.

4 Sec. 3. The state conservation commission, the governor,  
5 and the state comptroller are hereby authorized to obtain and  
6 accept federal grants to the state to be used in connection  
7 with the funds appropriated in this Act and federal funds in  
8 addition thereto.

9 Sec. 4. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June 30,  
10 1973, of the state appropriations of this Act shall revert to  
11 the general fund of the state as of June 30, 1973.
