## A BILL FOR

1 An Act to establish permanent revolving funds for the depart-  
2 ment of public instruction for administering federally  
3 financed programs and to make appropriations therefor.

4 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

5 Section 1. Chapter two hundred fifty-seven (257), Code  
6 1966, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following  
7 section:

8 "There is hereby established a permanent revolving fund  
9 to be known as the 'veterans education administration re-  
10 volving fund'. From this fund shall be paid the salary and  
11 travel expenses of department of public instruction personnel  
12 supervising the veterans education program which will be re-  
13 imbursed by the veterans administration of the federal govern-  
14 ment. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of  
15 the state to the department of public instruction the sum of  
16 seven thousand five hundred (7,500) dollars for the purpose  
17 of establishing the fund.

18 If any surplus accrues to said revolving fund in excess  
19 of the original appropriation for which there is no anticipated  
20 need or use, the governor shall order such surplus to be de-  
21 posited in the general fund."

22 Sec. 2. Chapter two hundred eighty-three A (283A), Code  
23 1966, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following sec-  
24 tion:

25 "There is hereby established a permanent revolving fund for

1 the department of public instruction to be known as the  
2 'school lunch revolving fund'. From this fund shall be  
3 paid the cost of warehousing, handling and transportation  
4 of direct distribution of federal surplus commodities. The  
5 fund shall be reimbursed by pro rata cost of items to re-  
6 ceiving schools and institutions. There is hereby appropri-  
7 ated from the general fund of the state to the department of  
8 public instruction the sum of five thousand (5,000) dollars  
9 for the purpose of carrying out this section.

10 If any surplus accrues to said revolving fund in excess  
11 of the original appropriation for which there is no anticipated  
12 need or use, the governor shall order such surplus to be de-  
13 posited in the general fund."

#### EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 680

This Act establishes two revolving funds for the use of the department of public instruction and appropriates funds for such purposes.
