A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of
2 Iowa to the educational radio and television facility
3 board.

4 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

5 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from
6 the general fund of the state for each year of
7 the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending
8 June 30, 1971, the following amount, or so much
9 thereof as may be necessary, to the educational
10 radio and television facility board for administra-
11 tion and operation of the state's educational
12 television network\$579,000.00

13 Sec. 2. The educational radio and television facility board,
14 or the governor and state comptroller, are hereby authorized to
15 accept federal or private grants to the state to be used in
16 connection with the operation of the state's educational tele-
17 vision network. All grants to and the receipts of the educa-
18 tional radio and television board are hereby appropriated for
19 the purpose set forth in such grants and receipts.

20 Sec. 3. No moneys appropriated under this Act, or receipts
21 which may be used for the same purposes as said appropriations,
22 may be used for capital improvements.

23 Sec. 4. No moneys appropriated under this Act may be re-
24 imburshed or transferred to any local or county school board
25 unless agreements to make such reimbursements or transfers

1 are specifically approved in writing by the executive council.

2 Sec. 5. The provisions of chapter eight (8) of the Code
3 shall apply to this Act.

4 Sec. 6. The educational radio and television facility
5 board shall, not later than January 31, 1970, report to the
6 general assembly the overall effectiveness of the educational
7 television network. Such report shall set forth in detail
8 the scope of coverage, programming, and breadth of utilization,
9 including the results from surveys of elementary and secondary
10 school teachers regarding both qualitative and quantitative
11 elements of classroom television as an instructional aid,
12 the extent of joint use and coordination with other educational
13 communication facilities of the state, recommended long-range
14 utilization and development directions, and such other informa-
15 tion the board may deem of significant interest to the general
16 assembly.

17 Sec. 7. Where any laws of this state are in conflict with
18 this Act, the provision of this Act shall govern for the
19 biennium.

1 Amend Senate File 682 by adding after page 1, line 12, the
2 following new section and renumbering the subsequent sections:
3 "There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the
4 state the sum of \$13,714.00 to the educational radio and tele-
5 vision facility board to be used for production of a sound and
6 color film portraying the working of the General Assembly and
7 its members. Any of the above sum not expended by June 30, 1971,
8 shall revert to the general fund."
