# A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state for  
2 capital improvements and purchases of land for institutions  
3 under the board of regents including construction of new  
4 buildings, repairs, improvements, land purchases, replace-  
5 ments, or alterations, and providing for joint control for  
6 the expenditure thereof by the board of regents, the gover-  
7 nor, and the state comptroller.

8 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

9 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general  
10 fund of the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and  
11 ending June 30, 1971, to the board of regents the sum of seven  
12 million five hundred thirty thousand (7,530,000) dollars, or  
13 so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used to supplement  
14 any prior appropriations for capital improvement items for  
15 construction of new buildings, repairs, improvements, purchases  
16 of land, replacements, or alterations, or for any other capital  
17 expenditures the board of regents may deem necessary for the  
18 proper and necessary function of any institution under its  
19 jurisdiction and for the purchase of land for a western Iowa  
20 regents institution.

21 Sec. 2. Contracts for improvements for which funds are  
22 appropriated by this Act shall be submitted by the board of  
23 regents to the governor and the state comptroller, except that  
24 items commonly known as change orders need not be submitted to  
25 the governor and the state comptroller unless such change

We, the undersigned members of the conference committee appointed to  
consider the difference between the Senate and the House of Representatives
