1 An Act relating to licenses in the practice of medicine.

2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

3 Section 1. Section one hundred forty-seven point eighty

4 (147.80), Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking in line

5 six (6) of subsection seven (7), the word "five" and insert-

6 ing in lieu thereof the word "ten".

7 Sec. 2. Section one hundred forty-eight point five (148.5),

8 Code 1966, as amended by section one (1) of chapter one hundred

9 sixty-five (165), Acts of the Sixty-second General Assembly, is

10 hereby further amended as follows:

11 1. By striking from line eighteen (18) the word "fifteen"

12 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "twenty-five".

13 2. By striking from line twenty (20) the word "three" and

14 inserting in lieu thereof the word "five".

15 Sec. 3. Section one hundred forty-eight point ten (148.10),

16 Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking lines twenty-five (25)
