## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Consti-  
2 tution of the State of Iowa to require that members of the  
3 General Assembly be elected from single member legislative  
4 districts.

5 *Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of  
7 the State of Iowa is hereby proposed:

8 Article three (III) of the Constitution of the State of Iowa  
9 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new section:

10 "Section 39. In establishing senatorial and representative  
11 districts, the state shall be divided into as many senatorial  
12 districts as there are members of the senate and into as many  
13 representative districts as there are members of the house of  
14 representatives. One (1) senator shall be elected from each  
15 senatorial district and one (1) representative shall be elected  
16 from each representative district."

17 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment, having been  
18 adopted and agreed to by the Sixty-second General Assembly,  
19 thereafter duly published, and now adopted and agreed to by  
20 the Sixty-second General Assembly in this Joint Resolution,

1 shall be submitted to the people of the State of Iowa at the  
2 general election in November of the year nineteen hundred  
3 seventy in the manner required by the Constitution of the  
4 State of Iowa and the laws of the State of Iowa.
