SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 A Joint Resolution to provide that the authority conferred
- 2 on the executive council extends to and includes acquisi-
- 3 tion of property by gift, purchase, condemnation or
- 4 otherwise.
- 5 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 6 Section 1. House Joint Resolution seventeen (17), codified
- 7 as chapter four hundred eighty-two (482), Acts of the Sixty-
- 8 first General Assembly, is hereby amended by striking from
- 9 section four (4), line two (2), the words "purchase, or secure
- 10 options on," and inserting in lieu thereof the words "acquire
- 11 by gift, purchase, condemnation or otherwise, or secure options
- 12 on,".
- 13 Sec. 2. All actions and proceedings heretofore taken by
- 14 the executive council to acquire any and all parcels of real
- 15 property included or described in chapter four hundred eighty-
- 16 two (482), section four (4), Acts of the Sixty-first General
- 17 Assembly, by gift, condemnation or otherwise are hereby
- 18 legalized and in all respects, ratified, adopted, and confirmed.

EXPLANATION OF SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 30

H. J. R. 17, Acts of the Sixty-first General Assembly provides for acquisition of property for capitol grounds by "gift or purchase" in Sec. 4. Because condemnation is not specifically mentioned, some owners are resisting and threatening suit. This resolution amends H. J. R. 17 to make clear the power of condemnation.
