A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to disposition of obsolete copies of hunting,
2 fishing and trapping licenses.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. Chapter one hundred ten (110), Code 1971, is
5 amended by adding the following new section:

6 "The board of supervisors may order the county recorder to
7 destroy all triplicate copies of hunting, fishing and trapping
8 licenses which have been on file in the recorder's office for
9 five years or more."

EXPLANATION

11 This bill allows the county recorder to destroy hunting,
12 fishing and trapping license records that have been held for
13 five years or more. These records are of little value after
14 five years and their storage takes up considerable space
15 which simply is not available in most county courthouses.
