### A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the use of fees and funds received by  
2 the Iowa soldiers home.

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section two  
2 hundred nineteen point seventeen (219.17) of the Code, fees  
3 received by the Iowa soldiers home from persons who are main-  
4 tained as permanent residents in the intensive care unit known  
5 as the Three West Unit of the Sheeler Health Care Facility,  
6 and funds received on behalf of such residents from the fed-  
7 eral government, during the period commencing January 1, 1972  
8 and ending June 30, 1973, may be expended by the Iowa sol-  
9 diers home for general operating expenses commencing with  
10 the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 1973.  
11 The department of social services, in cooperation with the  
12 state comptroller, shall establish a proper method of  
13 accounting for the receipt and expenditure of such fees.

14 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,  
15 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publi-  
16 cation in the Mount Ayr Record-News, a newspaper published  
17 in Mount Ayr, Iowa, and in The Clinton Herald, a newspaper  
18 published in Clinton, Iowa.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill allows the Iowa soldiers home to expend the fees  
21 received from residents of a unit described in the bill for  
22 operating expenses as well as federal funds paid on behalf  
23 of such residents. If such funds cannot be expended the unit  
24 will be forced to close. The provision is temporary and can  
25 be corrected through the appropriation process during the  
26 Sixty-fifth General Assembly.
