## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the use of school lunch facilities by  
2 senior citizen organizations.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. Boards of directors of school corporations may  
5 authorize the use by senior citizen organizations of school  
6 lunch facilities subject to reasonable rules and regulations  
7 of the board. Such use shall not interfere with the use of  
8 the facilities for public school purposes. The board may  
9 charge for such use an amount not to exceed the cost to the  
10 district.

### 11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill allows school lunch facilities to be used by  
13 senior citizen organizations when authorized by the local  
14 school board and when such facilities are not being used  
15 for public school purposes.

5 under the provisions of this Act shall be deemed to have  
6 waived his right to file a claim against the state under  
7 the provisions of chapter twenty-five A (25A) of the Code  
8 for incidents arising out of such use."

2 1. Page 1, by adding after line 10 the following new  
3 section:  
4 "Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. A person using the school lunch facilities  
5 under the provisions of section one (1) of this Act  
6 shall be deemed to have waived his right to file a claim  
7 under chapter six hundred thirteen A (613A) of the Code  
8 against a municipality, as defined in section six hundred  
9 thirteen A point one (613A.1) of the Code, for incidents  
10 arising out of such use."
