# A BILL FOR

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
2 of the state to the educational radio and television facility  
3 board, the following amounts or so much thereof as may be  
4 necessary, for the purpose of purchasing land, equipment,  
5 and other material necessary for capital improvements and  
6 services necessary to provide educational radio and televi-  
7 sion communications for the entire state:

8 1. For the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1972 and end-  
9 ing June 30, 1973 the sum of eight hundred thousand (800,000)  
10 dollars allocated as provided in section three (3) of this  
11 Act.

12 2. For the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1973 and end-  
13 ing June 30, 1974 the sum of eight hundred thousand (800,000)  
14 dollars allocated as provided in section three (3) of this  
15 Act.

16 3. For the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1974 and end-  
17 ing June 30, 1975 the sum of eight hundred thousand (800,000)  
18 dollars allocated as provided in section three (3) of this  
19 Act.

20 Sec. 2. The educational radio and television facility  
21 board, the governor, and the state comptroller may accept  
22 federal or private grants to the state or accept as a gift  
23 any facilities or real property to be used in connection with  
24 the funds appropriated by this Act.

25 Sec. 3. The educational radio and television facility  
26 board shall develop plans and expend funds appropriated by  
27 section one (1) of this Act as follows:

28 1. Funds appropriated by subsection one (1) of section  
29 one (1) of this Act shall be expended for the extension of  
30 state communications and educational radio and television  
31 to the northeast and northwest areas of the state and the  
32 sum of not exceeding (four hundred thousand (400,000)) dol-

7 state and the sum of not exceeding four hundred thousand  
8 (400,000) dollars shall be used for each such area.

9 Sec. 4. Any unencumbered balance of appropriations pro-  
10 vided by section one (1) of this Act remaining as of the fol-  
11 lowing dates shall revert to the general fund as indicated:

12 1. Unencumbered funds appropriated by subsection one (1)  
13 of section one (1) of this Act shall revert on June 30, 1976.

14 2. Unencumbered funds appropriated by subsection two (2)  
15 of section one (1) of this Act shall revert on June 30, 1977.

16 3. Unencumbered funds appropriated by subsection three  
17 (3) of section one (1) of this Act shall revert on June 30,  
18 1978.

19 Sec. 5. When the educational radio and television facility  
20 board has approved a project to be financed with funds appro-  
21 priated by this Act, a description of said project and esti-  
22 mated cost shall be reported to the governor and state comp-  
23 troller for allocation of funds.

24 Sec. 6. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used  
25 for operating expenses.
