1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state of Iowa to the executive council the sum of
3 three hundred sixty thousand (360,000) dollars, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, to be used by the executive
5 council to pay the balance due to complete the purchase on
6 the purchase-option lease and addendum with Trailer Owners
7 Service Corporation, currently known as the Capitol
8 Industries, Incorporated, for the building known as the
9 GMC building and the adjacent parking lot at East Seventh
10 and Walnut streets in the city of Des Moines, including
11 expenses incident to fees, abstracting costs, and
12 appraisal fees.

13 Sec. 2. Any unencumbered balance of the funds
14 appropriated by this Act remaining as of June 30,
15 1973, shall revert to the general fund of the state.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill allows the state of Iowa to purchase the GMC
18 building and an adjacent parking lot in Des Moines in
19 accordance with a purchase-option in a lease and addendum
20 with the Trailer Owners Service Corporation. A maximum
21 of \$360,000.00 is appropriated for this purpose, and any
22 balance remaining shall revert to the general fund on
23 June 30, 1973.

REPORT OF THE CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

ON HOUSE FILE 1279

To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives:
