1 An Act relating to county and city programs for senior citi-
2 zens.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred thirty-two point three
2 (332.3), Code 1971, is amended by adding the following new
3 subsection:

4 "To appropriate moneys from the general fund to provide
5 programs benefiting senior citizens, including, but not limited
6 to, senior citizen centers, mobile meals, and counseling pro-
7 grams."

8 Sec. 2. Section four hundred four point ten (404.10), Code
9 1971, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

10 "To provide programs benefiting senior citizens, including,
11 but not limited to, senior citizen centers, mobile meals, and
12 counseling programs."

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill permits county boards of supervisors and city
15 councils to allocate county funds, or portions of the city
16 municipal enterprise fund, for the purpose of providing pro-
17 grams of benefit to senior citizens. The bill is permissive
18 and not mandatory and does not authorize the levy of taxes
19 beyond present millage limits.
