1 Section 1. Section one hundred nine point one hundred
2 ten (109.110), Code 1971, is amended as follows:

3 109.110 TRAPS AND TROTLINES ON BORDER RIVERS. It shall
4 be lawful to operate in the Mississippi and Missouri rivers,
5 one basket trap and one trotline provided the operator has
6 purchased a regular fishing license that is required in sec-
7 tion 110.17-and-pays-the-regular-fee-of-one-dollar-for-each
8 basket-trap-or-trotline. Each trap and trotline must have
9 attached thereto an identification tag as required in sec-
10 tion 109.107.

11 Sec. 2. Section one hundred ten point one (110.1), lines
12 one (1) to forty-seven (47), inclusive, Code 1971, is amended
13 as follows:

14 Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, no person
15 shall fish, trap, hunt, pursue, catch, kill or take in any
16 manner, or use or have possession of, or sell or transport
17 all or any portion of any wild animal, bird, game or fish,
18 the protection and regulation of which is desirable for the
19 conservation of the resources of the state, without first
20 procuring a license or certificate so to do and the payment
21 of a fee as follows:

22 Fishing licenses:

23 All persons legal residents of the state,
24 except as otherwise provided~~3.00~~ 5.00

25 All persons legal residents of the state and
26 sixty-five years of age or older, except as
27 otherwise provided 3.00

28 No person, resident or nonresident, required to have a fish-
29 ing license, shall fish for trout in waters designated by the
30 state conservation commission as "trout waters" without having
31 a special license stamp affixed to his fishing license.

32 Special trout fishing license stamp ~~3.00~~ 5.00

33 The proceeds from the sale of this stamp shall be used ex-
34 clusively to restock the "trout waters" designated by the state
35 conservation commission.

EXPLANATION

29 The fish and game division is supported entirely by revenue
30 received from the sale of hunting, fishing, and miscellaneous
31 license fees.

32 During the past eleven years, the division has had only
33 two small license increases of fifty-cents each. During this
34 same period, the cost of maintaining and developing the fish
35 and game program has increased steadily to a point where we

1 are dangerously close to exceeding our income. It is evident
2 that the state must enact an increase in license fees if this
3 division is to continue to maintain, develop, and provide
4 the type of program demanded by the user public.

5 The hunting and fishing license fees for legal residents
6 of this state who are sixty-five years of age or older re-
7 main unchanged.

CORRECTED EXPLANATION

This bill provides for **increases** in certain hunting and fishing license fees, except that the fees for residents who are sixty-five years of age or older remain unchanged. The bill also reduces the number of persons eligible for deer hunting permits issued without fee.

During the past eleven years, the division has had only two license increases of fifty cents each. During the same period, the cost of maintaining and developing the fish and game program has increased steadily to a point where the division is close to exceeding its income.

A change is provided in the issuance of free deer hunting permits because of the apparent abuses. Last year the Commission issued 21,477 free deer hunting permits. ~~It is not~~ uncommon for several free permits to be issued to one family including small children and nonhunting women, and to short-term lessees. This bill limits the number of free deer hunting permits to one per farm unit.
