## A BILL FOR

1 An Act to provide compensation for the public representatives  
2 serving on the committee on child labor.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. Section ninety-two point twenty-one (92.21),  
5 Code 1971, is amended as follows:

6 92.21 COMMITTEE ON CHILD LABOR. There is hereby estab-  
7 lished a committee on child labor. The committee shall consist  
8 of the labor commissioner who shall act as chairman, the  
9 superintendent of public instruction or his designee, a  
10 representative of the Iowa employment security commission  
11 selected by the commission, and two persons representing the  
12 public and interested in child labor, to be appointed by the  
13 governor, without regard to political affiliation. The public  
14 representatives shall serve for a term of four years from  
15 July 1, 1970, and until their successors are appointed and  
16 qualify. The governor shall fill any public member's vacancy  
17 for any unexpired term. Public members shall receive  
18 ~~compensation for service on this committee as shall be~~  
19 ~~provided by the general assembly~~ a per diem of forty dollars  
20 and actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance  
21 of their official duties.

22 The committee shall adopt rules and procedure for its meet-  
23 ings and activities.

24 It shall be the duty of the committee to hold public  
25 hearings, to formulate rules more specifically defining the

1 occupations and equipment permitted or prohibited herein,  
2 to determine occupations for which work permits shall be  
3 required, and to issue general and special orders prohibiting  
4 or allowing the employment of persons under eighteen years  
5 of age in any place of employment hazardous to the health,  
6 safety, and welfare of such persons as defined in this chapter.

7 EXPLANATION

8 The Committee on Child Labor consists of the Labor Commis-  
9 sioner, the Superintendent of Public Instruction or his desig-  
10 nee, a member of the Employment Security Commission, and two  
11 public representatives appointed by the governor.

12 This bill provides compensation for the two public repre-  
13 sentatives of a per diem of forty dollars and actual and  
14 necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their  
15 official duties.
