1 Section 1. Section two hundred ninety-seven point twenty-
2 two (297.22), Code 1971, is amended by adding the following
3 new paragraph:

4 "The board of directors of any school corporation may,
5 subject to sections two hundred ninety-seven point twenty-
6 three (297.23) and two hundred ninety-seven point twenty-
7 four (297.24) of the Code, sell, lease, or dispose of real
8 estate upon which a structure has been erected by students
9 as part of a regular course of study."

10 Sec. 2. Any sales of property described by section one
11 (1) of this Act, made prior to the effective date of this
12 Act, which were made in the manner authorized by section
13 one (1) of this Act, shall be deemed to have been made in
14 compliance with the provisions of this Act, and to this
15 extent the provisions of this Act are retroactive.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill provides that schools may sell land, upon which
18 students have erected a structure as part of a course of in-
19 struction, without voting on the issue at an election. The
20 Code presently requires a vote if the value exceeds certain
21 amounts. This would cause elections to be required for the
22 sale of houses constructed by industrial arts students during
23 their course of instruction.
