1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the department of public instruction for the
3 biennium beginning July 1, 1971, and ending June 30, 1973,
4 the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
5 to be used for the following purposes, to wit:

27 financial assistance for strength-
28 ening sciences, mathematics,
29 modern foreign language instruc-
30 tion and other critical subjects;
31 (b) administration by the depart-
32 ment and the several school dis-
33 tricts of the state for guidance,
34 counseling and testing; and (c)
35 improvement and expansion of the

7 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
8 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
9 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
10 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1,
11 1971, shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state
12 treasury and to the credit of the fund from which appropri-
13 ated. In all other respects the provisions of section eight
14 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appro-
15 priations made for the first fiscal year of such biennium.
16 Unencumbered or unobligated balances of appropriations made
17 for the second fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject
18 to section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

19 Sec. 3. When any laws of this state are in conflict with
20 this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
21 biennium.

22 Sec. 4. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used
23 for capital improvements.
