7 3. Page 2, lines 6 and 7, by striking the following:  
8 "1972-73  
9 Fiscal Year"  
10 and by striking the numerals appearing under that column  
11 on pages 2 and 3.

20 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts  
 21 of these departments and their divisions are appropriated  
 22 for the purpose set forth in such federal grants or receipts.

23 Sec. 3. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used  
 24 for capital improvements.

25 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
 26 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
 27 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
 28 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971  
 29 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury  
 30 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In  
 31 all other respects the provisions of section eight point  
 32 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations  
 33 made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered  
 34 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second  
 35 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight

1 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

2 Sec. 5. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict  
3 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for  
4 the biennium.
