## SENATE AMENDMENT TO HOUSE FILE 705

1 Amend House File 705, page 2, line 18, by inserting the  
2 following after the period:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
2 of the state for the department of history and archives for  
3 each fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971 and  
4 ending June 30, 1973, the following amounts, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, to be used in the manner designated:

11 Sec. 2. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used  
12 for capital improvements.

13 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
14 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
15 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
16 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971  
17 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury  
18 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In  
19 all other respects the provisions of section eight point  
20 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations  
21 made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered  
22 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second  
23 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight  
24 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

25 Sec. 4. All federal grants to and the federal receipts  
26 of the agencies receiving funds under this Act are appropri-  
27 ated for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or re-  
28 ceipts.
