13 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
14 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered
15 or unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act
16 for the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1,
17 1971 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state
18 treasury and to the credit of the fund from which appropri-
19 ated. In all other respects the provisions of section eight
20 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropri-
21 ations made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Un-
22 encumbered or unobligated balances of appropriations made for
23 the second fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to
24 section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

25 Sec. 3. When any laws of this state are in conflict with
26 this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
27 biennium.

28 Sec. 4. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
29 of this department and divisions thereof are hereby appro-
30 priated for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or
31 receipts.

32 Sec. 5. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be
33 used for capital improvements.

Requested by Senator Conklin.

Prepared in regard to Conklin amendment to H. F. 709, filed June 17, 1971, an Act making an appropriation from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the department of public instruction. Following is the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal as required by Rule 31.

Revenue, based on the current certificate fee, for the last fiscal year, 1969-1970, amounted to \$36,834. The expense for the administration and processing of teachers' certificates for the same fiscal year amounted to \$181,914.

The following is the estimated revenue based on the maximum certificate fee proposed in this amendment and the estimated expense for the administration and processing of teachers' certificates:

It is anticipated that there will be a decrease and a stabilization in the number of certificates issued during the next five years.

2 1, by inserting after line 18 the following section:
3 "Sec. ____ Chapter two hundred fifty-eight (258),
4 Code 1971, is amended by adding the following new
5 section:
6 1. There is created within the office of the
7 treasurer of state a vocational youth organization fund.
8 Moneys deposited in the fund shall be used to develop
9 leadership in the youth of Iowa who are enrolled in
10 vocational and occupational education programs and to
11 encourage the youth of Iowa to pursue vocational and
12 occupational education.
13 2. The board for vocational education is authorized
14 to award grants from the vocational youth organization
15 fund to any vocational organization which is an integral
16 part of the instructional program in occupational-
17 vocational areas which includes, but is not limited to,
18 agriculture, business and office occupations, distributive
19 education, home economics, and trade and industrial
20 education. No moneys shall be used for salaries and travel

22 organizations. No vocational organization shall receive
23 more than one-fifth of the moneys appropriated to the
24 vocational youth organization fund in any year.
