A BILL FOR

1 An Act appropriating funds transferred to the marine fuel
2 tax fund to the state conservation commission.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. 1. There shall be transferred from the motor
2 vehicle fuel tax fund to the marine fuel tax fund the sum
3 of one million one hundred forty-one thousand one hundred
4 fifty-three (1,141,153) dollars for use in the fiscal year
5 commencing July 1, 1971, and the sum of one million one hundred
6 ninety-four thousand eight hundred thirty-one (1,194,831)
7 dollars for use in the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1972,
8 by the state conservation commission, in the manner provided
9 by this Act.

10 2. There is appropriated from the marine fuel tax fund
11 for each fiscal year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1971
12 and ending June 30, 1973 to the state conservation commission,
13 division of lands and waters, the following amounts, or so
14 much thereof as may be necessary, to be deposited in the state
15 conservation fund, to be used for the following purposes:

27 From funds appropriated by this Act the following minimum
28 amounts shall be expended for the purposes provided in sub-
29 sections one (1) through five (5) of section three hundred
30 twenty-four point seventy-nine (324.79) of the Code, for the
31 following enumerated projects:

32 Walters Creek Watershed	\$19,000.00
33 Big Creek	\$87,500.00
34 Lake Manawa	\$75,000.00
35 Pleasant Creek	\$100,000.00

1 Funds in excess of the amounts herein provided may be ex-
2 pended for the enumerated projects. Notwithstanding section
3 two (2) of this Act, the unencumbered or unobligated balances
4 of the minimum amounts for the projects enumerated and any
5 other unencumbered or unobligated balances of funds specifi-
6 cally allocated for such projects shall not revert to the
7 fund from which appropriated until June 30, 1975.

8 3. Funds appropriated by this Act for deposit in the state
9 conservation fund, which may be used for administrative pur-
10 poses, shall be subject to any limitation imposed in any other
11 Act of the general assembly upon the expenditure of funds
12 for administrative purposes, and the provisions of this Act
13 shall not be construed as making available funds for
14 administrative purposes which are in addition to any limitation
15 of funds for administrative purposes.

16 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
17 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
18 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
19 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971
20 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury
21 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In
22 all other respects the provisions of section eight point
23 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations
24 made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
25 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
26 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
27 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

28 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
29 of the state conservation commission, division of lands and
30 waters, are appropriated for the purpose set forth in the
31 federal grants or receipts.

32 Sec. 4. Where any laws of this state are in conflict with
33 this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
34 biennium.

1 Amend House File 719 as follows:
2 1. Page 2, by striking lines 1 through 26, inclu-
3 sive, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
4 "Section 1. Pursuant to section three hundred twenty-
5 four point eighty-three (324.83) of the Code, there shall
6 be transferred from the motor vehicle fuel tax fund to
7 the marine fuel tax fund a portion of moneys collected
8 under chapter three hundred twenty-four (324) of the
9 Code which is attributable to motor fuel used in
10 watercraft which portion shall be computed as follows:
11 1. Determine monthly the total amount of motor fuel
12 tax collected under chapter three hundred twenty-four
13 (324) of the Code and multiply such amount by nine-tenths
14 of one percent.
15 2. Subtract from the figure computed pursuant to
16 subsection one (1) of this section three percent of such
17 figure for administrative costs and further subtract
18 from such figure the amounts refunded to commercial fish-
19 ermen pursuant to subsection fourteen (14) of section
20 three hundred twenty-four point seventeen (324.17) of
21 the Code. All moneys remaining after all claims for
22 refund and the cost of administration have been made
23 shall be transferred to the marine fuel tax fund.
24 There is appropriated from the marine fuel tax fund
25 for each fiscal year of the biennium beginning July 1,
26 1971 and ending June 30, 1973 to the state conservation
27 commission, division of lands and waters, such amounts
28 of funds computed as provided in subsections one (1)
29 and two (2) of this section, which funds shall be de-
30 posited in the state conservation fund for use in the
31 state conservation commission recreational boating pro-
32 gram as provided in subsections one (1) through five
33 (5) of section three hundred twenty-four point seventy-
34 nine (324.79) of the Code."
