25 7 the respective appropriation committees or a sub-  
8 committee thereof shall hold a hearing upon such  
9 application while the general assembly is in regular

1 Section 1. The transfer of funds to the administration  
 2 fund of the state conservation commission in compliance with  
 3 the provisions of section one hundred seven point seventeen  
 4 (107.17) of the Code shall not exceed the following stated  
 5 amounts for each year of the biennium:

12 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
 13 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
 14 unobligated balances of transfers or appropriations made by  
 15 this Act for the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing  
 16 July 1, 1971 shall, on September 30, 1972 revert to the state  
 17 treasury and to the credit of the fund from which transferred  
 18 or appropriated. In all other respects the provisions of  
 19 section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall  
 20 apply to appropriations made for the first fiscal year of  
 21 the biennium. Unencumbered or unobligated balances of  
 22 transfers or appropriations made for the second fiscal year  
 23 of such biennium shall be subject to section eight point  
 24 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

25 Sec. 3. All receipts and all refunds and reimbursements  
 26 related to activities funded by the administration fund are  
 27 appropriated to the administration fund.

28 Sec. 4. The functions of county conservation board activi-  
 29 ties, planning and coordination, and the conservation educa-  
 30 tion center near Springbrook State Park shall be included  
 31 within the division of administration of the state conserva-  
 32 tion commission in addition to the current functions.

33 Sec. 5. Where any of the laws of this state are in con-  
 34 flict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern  
 35 for the biennium.
