7 herein set and the respective appropriation com-  
8 mittees or a subcommittee thereof shall hold a hear-  
9 ing upon such application while the general assembly  
10 is in regular session."

 3 for the biennium beginning July 1, 1971 and ending June 30,  
 4 1973, the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be  
 5 necessary, to be deposited in the state conservation fund  
 6 and used for the following purposes, to wit:

7 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts  
8 of these departments and divisions thereof are appropriated  
9 for the purpose set forth in such federal grants or receipts.

10 Sec. 3. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used  
11 for capital improvements.

12 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
13 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
14 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
15 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971  
16 shall, on September 30, 1972 revert to the state treasury  
17 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In  
18 all other respects the provisions of section eight point  
19 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations  
20 made for the first fiscal year of the biennium. Unencumbered  
21 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second  
22 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight  
23 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

24 Sec. 5. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict  
25 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for  
26 the biennium.
