1 Section 1. There is appropriated to the state conserva-
 2 tion commission from the general fund of the state of Iowa
 3 for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1971 and end-
 4 ing June 30, 1973, the following amounts, or so much thereof
 5 as may be necessary, to be used for the following purposes:

22 4. Any unobligated balance remaining after any of the specific
 23 projects included in this section are completed may be used to
 24 supplement the amount available for any other project financed
 25 by this Act.

26 Sec. 3. The state conservation commission, the governor,
 27 and the state comptroller are authorized to obtain and accept
 28 federal grants to the state to be used in connection with
 29 the funds appropriated in this Act and federal funds in
 30 addition thereto.

31 Sec. 4. When the state conservation commission has approved
 32 a project to be financed with funds appropriated by section
 33 one (1) of this Act, a description of the project and estimated
 34 cost shall be reported to the budget and financial control
 35 committee for approval. Upon approval by the budget and fi-

1 nancial control committee the project shall be reported to
2 the governor and state comptroller for allocation of funds.

3 Sec. 5. Any unencumbered balance of the funds appropriated
4 by section one (1) of this Act remaining as of June 30, 1975
5 shall revert to the general fund of the state as of June 30,
6 1975.

7 Sec. 6. Of the amount credited to the primary road fund
8 of the highway commission for state institutional and state
9 park roads under section three hundred twelve point two
10 (312.2), subsection five (5) of the Code, for the fiscal year
11 beginning July 1, 1971 and ending June 30, 1972, the sum of
12 seventy-five thousand (75,000) dollars, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, shall be used for the construction of
14 a multiple span bridge over the Little Sioux River in Wanata
15 state park south of Peterson in Clay county. The work shall
16 be accomplished under the direction of the state highway
17 commission.
