4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
2 of the state for each year of the biennium beginning July  
3 1, 1971 and ending June 30, 1973, for the department of  
4 agriculture and its divisions, the following amounts, or so  
5 much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the following  
6 purposes:

23 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts  
24 of these departments and divisions thereof are appropriated  
25 for the purpose set forth in such federal grants or receipts.

26 Sec. 3. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used  
27 for capital improvements.

28 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
29 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
30 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
31 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971  
32 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury  
33 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. The  
34 department of agriculture may make application to the com-  
35 mittees on appropriations for the reapportionment of any funds

1 that do revert, or probably will revert upon the dates herein  
2 set and the respective committees on appropriations or a sub-  
3 committee thereof shall hold a hearing upon the application  
4 while the general assembly is in regular session. In all  
5 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-  
6 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made  
7 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered  
8 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second  
9 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight  
10 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

11 Sec. 5. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict  
12 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for  
13 the biennium.
